

Directions: Today we talked about the early literacy skill of letter knowledge, which is knowing that letters are different from each other and that the same letter can look different ways. It is also knowing that letters relate to sounds. Discuss with your child how there is both a capital B and a lowercase b on the page, point out which one is which, and talk about how the letter Bb makes the "buh" sound. Next, have the child trace them with their fingers and then color them. Then point to each object on the page and have your child tell you what it is and then color it.
