Diabetes is a disease in which your blood glucose, or sugar, levels are too high. Glucose comes from the foods you eat. Insulin is a hormone that helps the glucose get into your cells to give them energy. With [Type 1 diabetes](#), your body does not make insulin. With Type 2 diabetes, the more common type, your body does not make or use insulin well. Without enough insulin, the glucose stays in your blood.

Over time, having too much glucose in your blood can cause [serious problems](#). It can damage your [eyes](#), [kidneys](#), and [nerves](#). Diabetes can also cause heart disease, stroke, and even the need to remove a limb. Pregnant women can also get diabetes, called [gestational diabetes](#).

Symptoms of Type 2 diabetes may include fatigue, thirst, weight loss, blurred vision and frequent urination. Some people have no symptoms. A blood test can show if you have diabetes. Exercise, weight control and sticking to your meal plan can help control your diabetes. You should also monitor your glucose level and take [medicine](#) if prescribed.

Spotlight on Medicine: June

If the dead rise from their graves and begin to eat the living, will you be ready? Recently, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) asked that tongue-in-cheek question on its "Public Health Matters" blog in an entry called "Preparedness 101: Zombie Apocalypse."



After a brief history of flesh-eating zombies in folklore, literature, film, and television, the post examines origin theories from a medical point of view—everything from a fictitious infectious condition called "ataxic neurodegenerative satiety deficiency syndrome" (from a mock paper by Harvard psychiatrist Steven Scholzman) to radiation sickness to a mutation in agents that cause real illnesses such as prion diseases, measles, and rabies. Zombie scenarios are often imagined as epidemics and pandemics involving viral infections spread through biting or contact with bodily fluids.

The blog then reveals its true intention—using a trendy pop culture topic to discuss how to prepare for an actual emergency, such as an earthquake, flood, hurricane, or tornado. It recommends having an emergency kit in the house for surviving the first days following a disaster: water, food, medications, tools, sanitation and hygiene supplies, clothing and bedding, important documents, and first aid supplies for treating small cuts and lacerations. It also suggests creating an emergency plan that includes a family meeting place, a list of emergency contacts, and an evacuation route. The post ends by describing how the CDC would investigate a zombie outbreak or any other epidemic disease, a field called epidemiology.

So listen to the CDC to be prepared for any emergency—even an attack by the living dead!

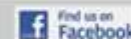
