

Download Adobe eBooks




Download eBooks to your computer or transfer them to an e-reader. There are never overdue items or late fees; titles automatically return to the Library's collection when due.

Prepare Your Computer

1. Before you begin, install the free software Adobe Digital Editions. From your home computer, go to www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions. This only needs to be done once.
2. Create an Adobe ID which will enable you to transfer to a supported portable device.

Choose a Title

1. Go to www.mppl.org/books/download
2. Click on 
3. Select a title for download:
 - Browse by format
 - Search by title or author
 - Find currently available titles with *Advanced Search*

4. Click **add to cart**.
5. Click **Proceed to Checkout**.
6. On *Sign In* page, select Mount Prospect Public Library from the drop-down menu.
7. Enter Library card number (14 digits, no spaces).
8. Once logged in, click **Confirm check out**.

Download Your Title

1. Click the **Download** icon under the book cover art.
2. Choose **Save** and click **OK**. Note where file is being saved.
3. All downloaded books will appear in the Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) console. You will use ADE to manage checked out materials and to read eBooks on your computer.

To Transfer a Title to a Portable Device

1. Connect a supported eBook device to the computer.
2. In ADE, select **Library View** (in the upper left corner).
3. Click on the Adobe eBook you want to transfer.
4. Drag the eBook to the eBook device icon in the left pane of ADE. The *Copy Documents* dialog box is displayed and the title is transferred.
5. When transfer is complete the dialog box will close. Disconnect the eBook device and enjoy.

To Return Adobe eBooks Early

1. In ADE, select **Library View**.
2. Under the *Bookshelves* heading, select **Borrowed**.
3. Click the eBook you want to return.
4. Click the **Item Options** arrow (in the upper left corner of the selected eBook).
5. Select **Return Borrowed Item**.
6. Click **Return** to verify that you want to return the title.

Downloading Tips

1. To access the service, your MPPL card must be in good standing.
2. A video introduction is available from the *My Media Mall* site. Select the *Guided Tour* in the left-hand menu. From the contents, choose **Adobe eBooks** near the bottom of the list.
